OBJECTS OF THE ASSOCIATION

- (A) To be a regional advocacy, information and community development agency operating to assist persons in need of relief from poverty, sickness, suffering, distress, misfortune, disability or helplessness (“persons in need”).
- (B) To support groups and people who are socially disadvantaged and persons in need to become engaged in their communities and develop greater control over their lives.
- (C) To resource and support groups and organisations that provide direct assistance to persons in need of relief from poverty, sickness, suffering, distress, misfortune, disability or helplessness.
- (D) To contribute to a creation of a sustainable and liveable community and urban environment for the people of the inner Sydney region, in particular people in need.
- (E) To be an independent voice on issues impacting on communities and the environment to the region.
- (F) To apply and promote the values of social justice.
- (G) To build communities’ capacities to respond to issues and address local concerns.
- (H) To promote the provision of a cooperative network of community services and infrastructure that responds to the needs of the region’s people, in particular persons in need.
- (I) To resource community activity consistent with these objects through providing regional information and advocacy.
- (J) To work with other agencies and groups to build partnerships which advance these projects.
